

## ***DIS Magazine* Index Online**



Thanks to the work of the Hekman Library at Calvin College in Grand Rapids, Michigan, over 1,780 articles in the *dis magazine* are now indexed in the 'Christian Reformed Church Periodical Index' (CRCPI) database. The database is an index of the official publications of the Christian Reformed Church and of publications that have ties to the denomination. The database can be searched at [\[www.calvin.edu/library/database/crcpi/\]](http://www.calvin.edu/library/database/crcpi/)

The index can be searched by keyword, subject, author, and publication, among other terms. Article citations are also linked by common subject and other terms, allowing the researcher to pull up citations to all related article citations. Inclusion in the CRCPI index will make the many articles published over the years in the *dis magazine* accessible to scholars, college students and other lifelong learners.

The full text of articles from some issues of the *dis magazine* are available on the *dis magazine* website [[www.xodian.com/dismagazine](http://www.xodian.com/dismagazine)] and the Calvin College Hekman Library maintains a physical collection of the full set of *dis magazines*.
