

#### **Reference**Universe



One of Hekman Library's newest research resources is **Reference Universe**. Reference Universe enables users to search the local reference collection, print and electronic, down to the article and index level--something WebCat is not designed to do. **It contains more than 20 million citations to 20,000 reference works**. One can search local holdings only or the wider database, which includes holdings from all libraries that have implemented Reference Universe.
