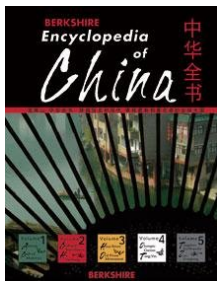




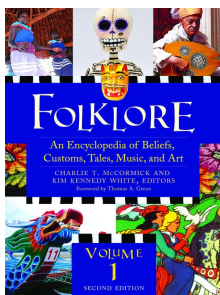

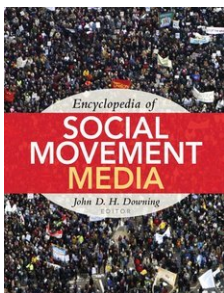

Help with Citing Your Sources



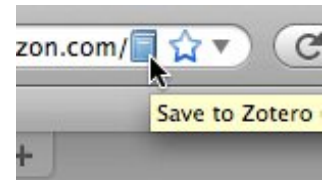
Ready to turn your paper in, but just need to finalize the bibliography? You could try our very own KnightCite to generate your citations.

Another free citation management tool we recommend is Zotero (www.zotero.org).

As a web browser add-on, Zotero is a very handy way to capture citations as you research the web and our library resources; it's also useful because it helps you store and organize citations for long-term research projects (think Honors or cap-stone papers).
